Dear Parishioners, Devotees and Pilgrims of Our Lady of Velankanni,

Hearty welcome for the 54th Annual Novena to Our Lady of Velankanni

This year also the effect of the Corona virus is very severe, therefore, we once again have to follow the Government Covid 19 restrictions and guidelines from the Archdiocese of Bombay. Hence the 54th Annual Novena Masses will be live streamed through different media channels.

The month of August is dedicated to **The Immaculate Heart of Mary**. Though the memorial is celebrated on 9th of June, yet the month is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The entire month falls within the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green.

Focus of the Liturgy: The Gospel readings for the Sundays in August 2021 are taken from St. John, St. Luke and St. Mark and are from Year B, Cycle 1.

August 1st - 18th Sunday of Ordinary Time	Jesus said in this Gospel, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst."
August 8th - 19th Sunday of Ordinary Time	"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."
August 15th - The Assumption of Blessed Virgin Mary	The Gospel relates the encounter of Mary with St. Elizabeth and Mary's Magnificat.
August 22nd - 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time	In this Gospel, Peter tells Jesus, "You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."
August 29th - 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time	Jesus admonishes the Pharisees.

Our traditional Annual Novena to Our Lady of Velankanni is a long standing tradition coming from 1968 with the flag hoisting first time to mark the beginning of Novena to Our Lady of Velankanni at Irla.

Unfortunately, since last year due to Corona virus effect, we are unable to conduct the Novena Services in the way we used to organize in the past. This year too, we are facing the same situation. We have to watch the Novena masses on either Youtube or media channel.

I understand your desire Dear Devotees, as you would like to physically participate in the Annual Novenas. In the years prior to Covid 19, I saw great crowds attend the Novena Masses and still larger crowd attending the procession with the Statue of Our Lady of Velankanni. We really miss such prayerful devotion during the Annual Novenas.

In spite of all the difficulties, we will try to participate in the Annual Novena Masses from our home, faithfully praying for all, especially for the eradication of Corona Virus from the surface of the Earth. God bless you all and May Our Lady of Velankanni Intercede for all of us!

HEALTHCARE OUTREACH: AN ARCHDIOCESE OF BOMBAY INITIATIVE

Bombay Catholic Sabha (Irla Unit) on 3rd July, 2021 enrolled 29 SVP Aided families of our Parish for the Archdiocese Healthcare Outreach.









The aim of this outreach is to provide affordable healthcare services to:

Economically weak; 2. Home-bound Senior citizen;
People with life limiting diseases i.e. paralysis, cancer, dementia, etc.; 4. Psychological Ailments, 5. Others

Benefits Offered are:

- Discounted Medicines / Diagnostic Tests with collaborating vendors.
- 2. Free Tele guidance with Doctors.
- 3. Assistance with Government schemes for Medical Aid.

Requirements for Enrolment for Healthcare Outreach:

- 1. Orange Ration Card Xerox.
- 2. Income upto Rs. 1.50 Lacs annually.
- 3. Aadhaar Card Xerox.
- 4. Stamp size photograph.
- Blood Group details.
- 6. Number of family members.

Initially, it will be given to SVP Aided families. Later on will be issued on recommendation of SCC Coordinator/SVP Member and approval from Parish Priest.
